## Healing with horses

Situated in the heart of the Luberon (84) France, Equichance is an equine mediation and therapy centre that helps people confront and overcome their fears in a context of mutual respect and the natural environment.

#### Why equitherapy?

Horses have for a long time and across different cultures been seen to have special healing and therapeutic powers. Equine therapy is not about riding a horse but rather about being in close physical contact to establish a bond of trust and understanding; a relationship of confidence and equality between horse and person.



#### What's in a session?

- Introductions over lunch
- Introductions to the horses; grooming and meditation
- Walking with horses synchronisation of heartbeats
- Outdoor games & exercises
- Team work with both participants and the herd
- 1-on-1 time for everyone to master the basics
- Tea, biscuits and close
